SCC's supported missions:

Love INC (Love In the Name of Christ)- a ministry is to help organize local churches to help our community, as well as providing aid to those needing help.

Hope Pregnancy Center (HPC)- a ministry to women in a crisis pregnancy to choose life for their unborn child. They also share the gospel with these women.

Chrisitan Children's Ranch (Eagle ID)- a ministry which provides a safe place to live for children from troubled homes. They also provide a school for them.

Chrisitan Retirement Home (Boise ID)- housing meant for returning missionaries and retired ministers. It also provides houseing for qualified retired people.

Cove Chrisitan Camp (Cove OR)- provides Chrisitan summer camps for children, and a place where churches and organizations can hold retreats.

Boise Bible College (BBC) (Boise ID)- provides one and two year bible degrees, as well as four year degrees for students looking to go into minsitry.

Overseas Outreach- Rich Deaighton works with people in Ukraine to provide a basis to believe the gospel of Christ.

Food collection- Currently, this food is going to the Veterns Advocate for distribution to military families.
